Salvation: Free at Last! Part II

Last month I mentioned that you may be thinking about changing your life, and that God has a way of reaching us even when we are not even thinking about Him. Moreover, you may want to make a change, but you fail over and over. "**The good that you would That do you not. Instead, you find yourself doing the very thing you don't want to do.**" (**Romans 7:14-15**).

You may know you need to stop lying...stop giving excuses; stop cursing and swearing. And maybe you come to realize, I can't even stop scrolling! Hours go by, fixated on the foolishness; stuck on the sinful ways of others, or lured in to some false scam until your whole day has passed you by. Or maybe you get the burger king mentality. I gotta have it My way.

How can one be both? Paul says Nothing good lived in his flesh. Do you hear people say I'm a good person and wonder who they are trying to convince? God's Word says **"There is nothing good that lives in my, that is in my flesh."** Paul's honesty about his true state is the first step to hope. Admitting the sin is the first step to release. Because if we deny our true condition, if we say it ain't so, the bible says: **"We deceive ourselves and doom ourselves to remain a slave to sin."** (I John 1:8-10). The good news is there is hope! And it is in the Word of God: **"But if we confess our sin, God is faithful to forgive us of our sin."** (I John 1:9).

Like Paul you may be in a miserable state...sulking around in depression, tears falling form your eyes and you don't even know what you are crying about. Or maybe you are just tired of being tired all the time. Perhaps it's the slavery of alcohol that lures you into addiction, or the slavery of vaping and smoking. Are you enslaved to a Jezebel...or enslaved to a pimp...or could you be enslaved to the casino or to that mirror? Cast all that care on Him because he cares for you.

It could be your thoughts: What who said. What who did, or didn't do. Maybe you are obsessed with what THEY think about you. Or maybe it's the pornographic enslavement of your mind.

Paul writes: "I find a law that evil is present WITH me, even if I want to do good. There's a war raging within. This law of the flesh wages against the war in your mind and brings you to captivity in sin. So even though you want to do right, even though you want to do good; evil will press on every side. So that the good that you would do, that's not what you do, instead it's the sin that you keep on doing." (Romans 7:14-21).

What can you do? You need a new plan, Stan. Restore your joy, Roy; Get life back, Jack, and get yourself free! The only wages a slave has...the only hope slavery offered was a good death. The wage of continued sin is death...but the free gift of God is eternal life. (**Romans 6: 23-24**).

Paul discovered that the only answer to this miserable condition was Jesus Christ. Like Paul you ought to say: Who can set me free? Who can take these shackles off my feet? Listen to the words of the song: "Shacked by a heavy burden, beneath a load of guilt and woe. But then the hand of Jesus touched me and now I am no longer the same.

You can be renewed in your Spirit through the power of your confession. Speak the weakness or the sin to GOD. Let Him know it bothers you. Let Him know you realize that only He can make the pain go away. Only He can deliver you from this captivity, from this battlefield in your mind.

Paul ends **Romans 7** by saying "**Thanks be to God, that we are set free from the law of sin and death by the blood of Jesus.**" And he declares in **Romans 8:1, "And now there will be no condemnation.**"

The debt of sin that we owed...Jesus paid it all. It was all nailed to a cross on a hill called Calvary.

Cast Off Your Doubt: You Are Qualified for This

"Then Moses said to the Lord, O my Lord, I am not eloquent, neither before nor since You have spoken to Your servant; but I am slow of speech and slow of tongue." Exodus 4:10 (*NKJV*)

God has designed each of us for a specific purpose. He has told some of us what our specific purpose is; and for others He is still working on us to fulfill our specific purpose. We must understand that God will not give us or tell us to do something we were not already qualified to do. We must be firm in our faith and know that Our Heavenly Father has designed us with greatness in mind.

The enemy's job is to get us to believe that we are not qualified or we are not worthy enough to do the work God has commanded us to do. The enemy will place so much doubt in our mind that we could possibly question ourselves on if we are really God's child. We may think, how can God create someone who is not capable of doing something as simple as saying, "I love and forgive you because God has commanded me to?"

We get so lost in what the world has determined who can be qualified for this or for that. We forget that it is God who has made this world and everyone within it. How can "man" determine who is qualified? How can "man" be over God?

Short Answer: MAN CANNOT JUSTIFY WHO IS OR IS NOT QUALIFIED TO DO THE WORK OF GOD. GOD HAS THE ULTIMATE SAY AND HE HAS DEEMED YOU QUALIFIED.

God had hand-picked Moses to be the one to deliver the children of Israel from Egypt. Moses, like most of us, came up with every excuse for why he was not qualified. God had to remind Moses, did I not make man. If God created us, then He placed what was necessary for us to do the work that He had created for us to do. God knew who we were before we were even formed in our mother's womb. He knew what we would and would not do before we started walking in our purpose.

Today is the day we cast off all doubt and fear and walk in what God has commanded us to do. It is time to tell the enemy or anyone else who tells us we are under qualified that God has **QUALIFIED** me for this. God has **QUALIFIED** me to this position. God has **QUALIFIED** me to write and publish the book. God has **QUALIFIED** me to start the business. God has **QUALIFIED** me to run that marathon. God has **QUALIFIED** me to speak before millions on the Good News of Jesus Christ.

When we say God has **QUALIFIED** us, we must believe in our hearts and minds. This cannot be a simple quote we put on a T-shirt; but this must be our War Cry before all those who try to get us to question our qualification in God. Let today be the day where we stand strong in our faith and believe that we have been **QUALIFIED** by God to do all and more that He has for us to do.

Focus on the Marriage & Family - "Love One Another" (Part 9)

And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all men, even as we do toward you. ~ 1 Thessalonians 3:12

In the last article, I encouraged you to stay "woke" and expanded the concept to marriage and family relationships. In this article, I would like to direct your attention to the core of the whole matter at hand. The core of the family is being negatively altered and decimated by our "new" culture. In general, change is good. Unfortunately, the change our country is legislating and promoting is not good. In fact, it is downright evil. Stay woke and let not evil take residence in your home.

Make no mistake about it, for marriage and family relations to work, the foundation must be rooted in love. Bear in mind, that I said love, not lust. Eventually, lust will turn into rust. Paul urged the Thessalonians to love one another (1 **Thessalonians 3:12**). However, the details of "how" to love are not explained in this particular scripture. What love looks like in action is explained in my wife's favorite passage of scriptures, 1 **Corinthians 13:4-7** (*TLB*).

"Love is very patient and kind, never jealous or envious, never boastful or proud, (5) never haughty or selfish or rude. Love does not demand its own way. It is not irritable or touchy. It does not hold grudges and will hardly even notice when others do it wrong. (6) It is never glad about injustice, but rejoices whenever truth wins out. (7) If you love someone, you will be loyal to him no matter what the cost. You will always believe in him, always expect the best of him, and always stand your ground in defending him."

The question is, "How do we apply these scriptures?" Hint...whenever you take scriptures from paper to practice, don't over complicate it. Let me demonstrate using the table below.

Be patient with each other	Never be jealous or envious (spiteful)
Be kind to each other	Never be arrogant
Always tell the truth; be honest	Never be selfish or rude
Be loyal; support each other	Never be bully
Always expect the best of each other	Do not be irritable (grouchy) or oversensitive
Always have each other's back	Do not hold grudges or be bitter

Advice for Married Couples

You see, "real love is never rude; it is full of grace and charm. It does not behave unseemly (inappropriately). It does not go around hurting others' feelings. It always uses tact and politeness whenever possible. Love never demands its rights, but seeks its responsibilities toward others. It is not self-centered or self-assertive. Love does not fly off the handle. It does not lose its temper quickly. It is not easily exasperated at people. Love does not keep score in order to repay wrong for wrong. It forgives the evil that people do to it. It does not carry a grudge. Love is our participation in God's nature. Love is the only foundation for a joyful, fulfilling, and sustainable relationship." 


