We find in the Book of Hosea that God has a case against Israel. The case is simply a cause against Israel because there was no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land. And that, my friend, led to chaos and destruction. I have come to know and believe that we can't have real peace apart from God and His Word, no matter what anyone says.

Moreover, a growing problem with the world today is one of Biblical Illiteracy, not just by those in the world but also by those in the church. People just don't know the Word of God as they should and as they have been instructed to know it. They have respect for the Bible, yes, but by and large, they don't read and study it like they should, if at all. And because they don't read and study it, they don't have the knowledge of God and have become illiterates. Listen! It's a serious situation because America is becoming like Israel in Hosea's time. And it's not good!

Increasingly, America is becoming biblically uneducated. Not knowing the Word of God is like a poison, wreaking havoc in the lives of individuals, in our churches, and in our communities. To better understand what is happening, we need to consider two things: The poison of being ignorant and the antidote for getting educated. Failing to do so will make us part of the existing problem.

We'll start with talking about the poison of being ignorant. This poison has affected individuals, churches, and communities. Let's deal with ourselves first: as individuals.

As pointed out in **Hosea 4:6**, God's people have always been destroyed by the lack of knowledge. **Amos 8:11-13** teaches us that where there is a lack of God's Word, the people faint. Why? 1) In ignorance they make the wrong choices, and 2) When they stumble, they do not know where to turn for help. Consequently, they are always stuck in a rut, not knowing how to get out or free themselves!

Without a knowledge of God's Word, a person has no real direction or guidance in life. Listen to what **Psalms 119:105** says, **“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.”** Verses **111** and **165** go on to tell us that there can be no true joy or peace in life without the knowledge of God's Word. We have to love His Word! So the question is: How many lives are being destroyed? How many people are stumbling through life because they do not have the light of God's Word guiding them?

Our knowledge and obedience to His Word speaks loudly of our relationship with Him. And it is this relationship, this very close relationship with God that should penetrate and permeate the very fabric of our society!

And as individuals, it's imperative that we know and obey the Word of God! Bless His Holy Name!

## You Are Not Alone!

Greetings, Everyone!

In February, I shared with you that I lost my mother in November of 2024. The pain and emptiness that I am feeling brings on so many different emotions. There are days I smile when I think about her and then there are days that I become withdrawn, sad, and lonely. I know some of us have already lost a parent or both. Well, I have lost both. Not having your parents will make someone re-evaluate their life. An individual will look at their lifestyle, their family and friends, their job, and most importantly their relationship with God. So, what is sustaining me through my grief? The Word of God.

**“For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart” (Hebrews 4:12, *ESV*)** The Word of God can sort out what is of flesh and what is of the spirit. Christ understands that the death of a loved one is a painful experience, In **John 11:33-35**, Jesus responded both physically and emotionally as He identified with their sorrow. I encourage you to read these verses if you ever feel alone:

The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it” (John 1:1-5, *ESV*).**

Now replace the Word with Jesus:

“In the beginning was Jesus, and Jesus was with God, and Jesus was God. Jesus was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Jesus, and without Jesus was not anything made that was made. In Jesus was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.”

Jesus is my source and my healer. Jesus is the light that shines through my sadness that I may endure for now. He is my joy and my peace (**John 14:27**). Let’s continue to check on each other and pray for one another. You may assume that the person may be fine, but if God placed them in your heart to think about them, please be obedient and check-in. ## Focus on the Marriage & Family - "Shout for Joy" (Part 7)

Someone coined a phrase, "Happy Wife, Happy Life." The problem with this statement is that it sounds as if happiness in the relationship depends solely on the wife's mood and implies that her happiness is enough to generate a "happy life" for both. I think you can see the problem with this philosophy. Happiness, like respect, goes both ways.

Recently, someone revised this phrase to "Happy Spouse, Happy House." Now, this phrase includes both the husband and the wife, and places responsibility for happiness in the marriage on each person, not just the husband. The truth is, if generating and cultivating happiness in the marriage is only the responsibility of the husband, the relationship might be in serious jeopardy. I don't say this to demean men, but we must keep in mind that men are not typically raised in an environment that promotes their responsibility to foster happiness.

Most men are raised in environments that promote and define the man's role as a provider, which means the husband ensures the family has a home, food, transportation, and enough money to meet their financial obligations. Over the past 50 + years, there has been a constant and deliberate shift to make this a shared responsibility. More women have entered the professional work force to bring more money into the home to improve the family's standard of living, make ends meet, and in many cases, simply survive.

I suggest that when happiness has evaporated from your relationship, look at yourself first. Are you happy with yourself? If not, how does that impact your personality? How does that impact the way you treat your spouse and others? Do you take your unhappiness out on him/her? The most important question is, "WHY" are you unhappy? There is always a reason(s) on the surface and at the root. These are just a few essential questions you should address if you are suffering from unhappiness.

**Job 38:7** declares, "When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?" David said in **Psalm 5:11**, "But let all those that put their trust in thee rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be joyful in thee." **Psalm 32:11** says, "Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy, all ye that are upright in heart."

These three scriptures have one thing in common. They all remind us that the Bible instructs the righteous to "shout for joy." I have a dilemma with the interpretation of these scriptures. Does it mean we should shout (or yell) because of joy or shout to obtain joy? When we are happy, we smile because we feel good. Sometimes, we push or praise ourselves into happiness. Even David had to encourage himself in the Lord when he was stricken with overwhelming grief (**1 Samuel 30:6**).

In Pentecostal churches, we use the word "shout" to mean dance as well as scream. When we shout or dance, it changes our mood and the way we feel, even if only for a short time. Remember, every minute is a precious gift from God. The songwriter said, "If you're happy, say amen." If you are unhappy, what do you say? I think we do what the scripture says: "Shout for joy!" Shout for the things that God has done and shout for the things that we need God to do. The Children of Israel shouted with a loud voice as they marched around the city of Jericho, and the walls came tumbling down. Why did they shout? Because God told them to shout. Why should we shout? Because God is still telling His people to shout.

If you are reading this article and dealing with unhappiness, ask yourself the questions I mentioned above. Be honest with your answers. Don't stop with, "I don't know." Keep digging and seek help from a professional or someone you trust. I also encourage you to shout for joy. For when we shout for joy, it signifies victory, and good things begin to happen. It could even help restore the joy in your relationships.




