As we conclude the subject of Biblical Illiteracy in this edition, we want to examine two more antidotes that we can use to battle this crippling poison in our lives, our churches, and our communities. I have already shared with you that we need Private Daily Devotional Bible Reading and Frequent In-Dept Bible Study with Others. The next antidote is: Parents accepting their God-given responsibility. God gave the responsibility of spiritual training to the parents. **Deuteronomy 6:6-7** says, **“And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: (7) And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.”** Ephesians 6:4 declares, **“And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.”**

Even though churches may provide assistance with children’s learning, parents should not abdicate their responsibility to the church. In fact, parents should be very much involved in the teaching programs of the church. Are you willing to accept your parental duties to stamp out Biblical Ignorance?

Lastly, we who are preachers should fulfill our duty to the Word. Preachers are to give heed to the Word, and to preach the Word. **1 Timothy 4:16** tells us that we should, **“Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.”**

2 Timothy 4:1-5 tells us to, **“Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove (reprimand), rebuke (haul you over the coals), exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. (3) For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; (4) And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. (5) But watch**

thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.”

You should expect preachers to be “men of the Book,” preaching and teaching the Word of God, providing exposition of the Scriptures and not entertaining you with “pop theology” and “pop psychology. Are you willing to require that preachers proclaim the Word to stamp out Biblical Illiteracy?

In conclusion, I want to share with you a paragraph from an article titled *The Scandal of Biblical Illiteracy: It’s Our Problem* by Albert Mohler. This is what he says: “Churches must recover the centrality and urgency of biblical teaching and preaching, and refuse to sideline the teaching ministry of the preacher. Pastors and churches too busy – or too distracted – to make biblical knowledge a central aim of ministry will produce believers who simply do not know enough to be faithful disciples. We will not believe more than we know, and we will not live higher than our beliefs. The many fronts of Christian compromise in this generation can be directly traced to biblical illiteracy in the pews and the absence of biblical preaching and teaching in our homes and churches.”

He goes on to say, “This generation must get deadly serious about the problem of biblical illiteracy, or a frighteningly large number of Americans, Christians included – will go on thinking that Sodom and Gomorrah lived happily ever after.”

Are we willing, are you willing, to get deadly serious about the problem of biblical illiteracy? If so, then do what **James 1:21** admonishes us to do. **“Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.”** Be richly blessed!

Focus on the Marriage & Family – *Conflict Resolution* (Part 11)

Relationships appear to be more complicated than ever before. People are angry, frustrated, and unhappy with their lives. Unfortunately, they take out their anger on others, which creates toxic and unhealthy environments. This then leads to conflicts on various levels and can ruin a marriage and home. In which case, everyone loses.

Conflict resolution is a topic that is gaining more and more attention because more people are finding themselves in conflict, sometimes even with themselves. Conflict resolution is often defined as the process of finding a peaceful solution to a disagreement between two or more parties. It involves understanding different perspectives, identifying the root cause of the conflict, and working collaboratively to reach a mutually acceptable agreement. Effective conflict resolution aims to resolve disputes while preserving or even improving relationships.

There are a few key words worth highlighting in the definition above: process, peaceful, understanding root cause, collaboratively, agreement, and relationships. The best solutions are peaceful with win/win results. Researchers in conflict resolution have determined that the best approach to resolving conflicts is by using empathic listening, good communication skills, and emotional intelligence. I added a fourth point – “use of Biblical principles.”

Empathic listening is when one listens with the intent to understand how the speaker feels, in addition to understanding his/her ideas. Showing empathy involves identifying with a person’s emotions and situation, even if you are not in agreement with them. The goal is to enable the speaker to share emotions free from judgment or criticism.

Most people do not listen with the intent to understand; they listen with the intent to reply. This is why we often hear people say, “We are talking past each other.” No one wants to compromise, and the dialogue is practically of no benefit to either person. Here are some empathic listening techniques that are easy to implement:

- † Be interested in the speaker and what he/she has to say.
- † Have a caring spirit and try to see the situation from the other person’s perspective.
- † Have good eye contact and body language.
- † Ask the speaker to expand on his/her thoughts.
- † Don’t raise your voice, call your spouse names, or get sarcastic. Acting nasty will put a stop to any productive discussion you might have had.
- † Communication is not about winning, it’s about gaining understanding...”**Come let us reason together sayeth the Lord.**” (Isaiah 1:18) and “...**In all they getting, get understanding.**” (Proverbs 4:7).
- † “**And be ye kind one to another, tender hearted , forgiving one another, even as God for Christ’s sake hath forgiven you.**” (Ephesians 4:32).

In the words of Wayne Dyer, “Conflict cannot survive without your participation.”






