Bless the name of the Lord, and welcome to summer! I pray that you enjoy the days ahead with family, friends, and others you care about. Stay safe!

As we continue to deal with Biblical Illiteracy, we want to shift our focus to the antidote needed to combat this crippling poison in our lives, our churches, and our communities.

The first thing we need is Private Daily Devotional Bible Reading. The truly blessed person feeds upon the Word of God daily! **Psalm 1:1-3** declares, **“Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. (2) But his delight (his pleasure, his desire) is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. (3) And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.”**

Listen to what **Psalm 119:97-98** declares. **“O how love I thy law (thy direction and instruction)! it is my meditation (my reflection, my prayer, and my devotion) all the day. (98) Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they (your Words) are ever with me.”** My God!

We need to develop a systematic practice of prayerful Bible reading and study as part of our daily devotional, which will bring us closer to God. It will gradually increase our understanding of the Word of God and will offer strength, comfort, and hope that only the Scriptures can provide.

The second thing we need is Frequent In-Depth Bible Study with Others. The faithful Christian realizes the value of mutual or shared edification. The writer of Hebrews tells us exactly

what it is that we need to do. **Hebrews 3:12-14** says, **“Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. (13) But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day (this very day); lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin (sin will break you). (14) For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end.”**

And let’s not forget the words of **James 4:17**, **“Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.”**

Let’s examine **Hebrews 10:24-25**. **“And let us consider (observe and understand) one another to provoke (incite and motivate) unto love and to good works: (25) Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together (where there is safety), as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.”**

This is why church programs provide the opportunity for Christians to study together: Sunday morning Bible classes, Bible study during the week, and Bible study in the homes. Churches do this so you can benefit from the knowledge of other Bible students, not just the pastor or Sunday school teacher.

I will leave you with this question: What are you doing to remedy biblical ignorance in your life, in your church, and in your community? More to come!

Focus on the Marriage & Family – “Tell The Truth” (Part 10)

In last month’s edition, I focused our attention on the necessity of “love” to have a healthy relationship. I also provided practical behavioral advice that can help your marriage thrive, not just survive, per **1 Corinthians 13:4-7**. In this article, I will address a fundamental topic that often gets people into trouble...the Truth!

Most of us are really good at seeing others’ shortcomings and where they need to improve. Very few are good at conducting a thorough self-analysis to determine our weaknesses, let alone how to overcome them. I have discovered that the very thing people say they don’t need is exactly what they need. When someone says they don’t need counseling, they normally do need counseling. When someone says their prayer life is good, it’s normally not. Many people who say they love someone lack evidence of this assertion. So, the question is, why is it so hard for us to admit the truth? Why do we choose to live in an alternate reality? After all, **Proverbs 13:5** says, “**The Lord detests lying lips, but He delights in people who are trustworthy.**” **Revelation 21:8** says, “**But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.**”

The first step to improving anything in your life is to tell the truth. This is why in Catholicism, the prayer of confession starts with seven simple words, “Bless me, father, for I have sinned.” They openly and rightfully acknowledge the truth upfront. The truth clears the air and gets God’s attention. **James 4:16**, Jesus said, “**I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh to the Father except by Me.**” So, the truth leads us to God, which leads us to victory. From a natural perspective, the truth creates an atmosphere of integrity and produces good ground where by God can bring forth a harvest of blessings.

Liars tend to make the worst partners. It is very difficult to believe anything they say. This then makes for a toxic and dysfunctional environment. Married couples should be able to count on each other, believe in each other, and trust each other. Trust is built when you tell the truth at all times. Many marriages are destroyed because of lies. Once trust is lost, it is hard to regain.

There was a point in my marriage when I got tired of saying, “I’m sorry.” So, I made up my mind that I was going to try my best to behave in a manner where I didn’t need to say, “I’m sorry.” Truth is, I still have to say it, but not nearly as much as I used to because I use the **Silver Rule** → “Do unto others as they want you to do unto them.” This is different from the Golden Rule (**Luke 6:31**). The Golden Rule is the principle of treating others as you would have them do unto you. It is sometimes called an ethics of reciprocity, meaning you should reciprocate to others how you want them to treat you.

Treating a person the way they want to be treated is often tricky because many of us speak in abstract terms, such as the phrase “treat me with respect.” That is rather general. A better statement regarding respect is, “Please don’t raise your voice.” Now, that’s more explicit and easier to comprehend.

I implore you to build a relationship built on trust by telling the truth. The truth is a foundational principle of a godly marriage. Remember, the devil is the father of all lies and the truth is not in him (**John 8:44**). So, for God’s sake, and yours, tell the truth.


