We mentioned in Part III that growth and support in the body of Christ depend upon the effective working of every member. Allow me to state further that no program is successful without the help of the congregation. When I look at large churches, I see the support of the people in the rear. Somebody had a mind to support!

Secondly, in **1 Corinthians 12:12-22**, the Apostle Paul stresses the fact that all members and their diverse functions are vital! Take the time to study it. He teaches us that no one can say that they themselves are not important and that no one can say that others are not important. We all are important! Praise God! When we fail to realize this truth, it has disastrous results! Listen to this:

First of all, it can leave many of us disappointed, apathetic, and fruitless! If we are not careful, we can over-emphasize one work and neglect the important of other works. When we stress edification to the point of neglecting evangelism and benevolence, this can make some feel that only one kind of work is worthy, noble, or important. When we breed such misconceptions, some folks may involve themselves in a work for which they are not suited. So when failure occurs, they become disappointed. And unless they are shown alternative ways to serve, they can become apathetic and

fruitless. We don't need this in the body of Christ.

Secondly, it can hinder the Lord's cause in spreading the gospel! Lack of support has hindered many foreign or smaller works where evangelists or churches were unable to raise support needed to do the job. Look! If those at the rear do not appreciate the importance of their support, the Lord's body becomes handicapped in its ability to function! This is why churches want to know what areas of ministry you are comfortable in, or called to, so they can help maximize your potential.

My friend, when you realize the importance of both services (at the front and in the rear), don't despise one type of service over another! I encourage you to determine where you can best serve the Lord, and do so properly and with your whole heart. Why? Because you are important!

Listen! Both services are equally important: The front needs the rear and the rear needs the front. We need to remember that the ground that is gained by the folks up front is ground gained for the folks in the rear. As the battle advances forward, the support advances forward. They both move together! Never feel like you are not needed!

There are some other important things we need to discuss concerning our service to the Lord. Stay tuned and be blessed!

God Still Covers and Protects

Genesis 39: 21-23

“But while Joseph was there in the prison, (21) the Lord was with him; he showed him kindness and granted him favor in the eyes of the prison warden. (22) So the warden put Joseph in charge of all those held in the prison, and he was made responsible for all that was done there. (23) The warden paid no attention to anything under Joseph’s care, because the Lord was with Joseph and gave him success in whatever he did.”

Have you ever noticed how, even in seasons of deep despair, God still covers and protects His people? Joseph was an innocent man—wrongly accused and unjustly imprisoned because of the lie of Potiphar’s wife. Yet Scripture reminds us that even behind prison walls, the Lord was with him.

Joseph did not lose God’s presence because his circumstances changed. Instead, God’s favor followed him into the prison. That favor was so evident that the warden placed Joseph in charge of the other prisoners and entrusted him with everything that was done there. The Bible tells us the warden paid no attention to anything under Joseph’s care, because the Lord was with Joseph and gave him success in whatever he did.

What the enemy intended to use for destruction, God used for elevation. When the enemy whispers that failure is inevitable, God covers, protects, and anoints you to walk into the greatness He has already designed for you. Life brings both joy and hardship, but there are moments when the weight of our struggles seems heavier than our hope. We may feel stuck, forgotten, or convinced we will never make it through.

Yet this is where God steps in—as our loving Abba Father—placing His hand over us. Even in confined places, God causes His people to find favor. He elevates us at the appointed time, positions us for His purpose, and empowers us to do His work. Like Joseph, we are reminded that God’s presence—not our location—determines our success.

Take heart: God is with you in the prison seasons as much as He is in the palace ones. And when He elevates you, it will always be for His glory and honor.

Marriage Matters – *The Anointing* (Part 1)

HAPPY VALENTINE'S DAY!!! This is the 1st article in a series called Marriage Matters. Marriage is an institution that God established for the procreation and enjoyment of mankind. When Satan caught wind of this, he was immediately against marriage and started attacking, as is evidenced in the book of Genesis, where he wreaks havoc in the family structure, starting with Adam and Eve, and then with their sons, Cain and Abel. We still observe this today. But we must fight back and not let the trend continue. Our family structure and the health of the nation depend on the health of married couples.

In this article, I will share a key component to success that is applicable in most areas of our lives. And the good news is it comes from God. **In Scripture, “anointing” often refers to God setting someone apart and empowering them for a purpose.** Samson was clearly set apart from birth (as a Nazarite) and repeatedly empowered for deliverance. Therefore, it aligns with the concept of anointing as divine empowerment. **Judges 14:6** says, **“And the Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon him, and he rent him as he would have rent a kid, and he had nothing in his hand: but he told not his father or his mother what he had done.”** I suggest that the reference to the “Spirit of the Lord” is actually an anointing from God.

The Bible is silent on Samson’s size and physique. However, artists typically depict him as a very big and muscular man. I tend to think that he looked normal, which is why most didn’t fear him. The lion thought he was going to be lunch, but he was wrong because God occasionally empowered him with supernatural strength to fulfill a specific purpose. Samson was not strong because he went to LA Fitness and looked like Arnold Schwarzenegger. He was strong because he was anointed.

We know that God anoints us to preach and teach the Word of God, and sing unto the Lord. Jesus said in **Luke 4:18**, **“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor.”** However, I believe the anointing is multifaceted and that God can and does anoint us in other areas of our lives.

God desires that we (Christians) are the head and not the tail (**Deuteronomy 28:13**). Our weapons are not carnal... they are from God. That gives us an advantage to be better and accomplish our divine assignment(s). I submit that all married couples need to be anointed for marriage to be the best husband and the best wife they can possibly be. Here’s my proof.

In 1985, I had an encounter with a mirror in my bathroom. I was saved and sanctified, BUT like many couples, married & miserable. I told God this woman you gave me is no longer the one for me. I even had the audacity to tell Him, “Surely, I am not the problem because I’m saved and sanctified.” But God told me to look in the mirror. And when I looked in the mirror, God said, “You’re looking at the problem.” Ouch!

Long story short, I asked God to forgive me and anoint me to be the best husband I could be for His glory, and God did it. I am still working on being the best I can, but I am so thankful that God blocked the devil’s attempt to steal my marriage. Hallelujah! Now we teach marriage enrichment together because God set us apart and empowered us with purpose. The anointing destroys the yoke (**Isaiah 10:27**), which is a stronghold intended to keep us from fulfilling our purpose and reaching our destiny. But thanks be to God who always shows up on time. Be encouraged and seek God for an anointing to be the best spouse you can be, and watch your marriage relationship go to higher heights and deeper depths.

Christology Part II

Greetings, everyone!

Last year, we started to learn about Christology, which refers to the exploration of the life and activities of Christ. We also examined His titles, which serve to define His identity. This month, we are going to learn the divine nature, human nature, and character of Christ.

The divine nature of Christ starts with Him. Christ stated, “**Before Abraham was I AM**” (**John 8:58, NKJV**), “**I and My Father are one**” (**John 10:30, NKJV**), and “**O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was**” (**John 17:5, NKJV**). His divine nature possesses divine attributes, offices, prerogatives, relations, and worship. Christ’s divine nature is distinguished by several essential characteristics. First, He possesses divine attributes—qualities such as omnipotence, omniscience, omnipresence, and perfect holiness—which are unique to divinity.

In addition to these attributes, Christ holds divine offices, meaning roles that only God can fulfill, such as Creator, Sustainer, and Judge of all. He also has divine prerogatives, which refer to rights and privileges that belong exclusively to God, including the authority to forgive sins and grant eternal life. Furthermore, Christ’s divine nature is evident in His relations, such as His unique relationship with God the Father and with humanity. Finally, Christ is worthy of worship, a recognition reserved for God alone, confirming His divinity.

Christ experienced human development throughout His earthly life. This means He grew and matured physically, mentally, and emotionally, just as any other human being does. From childhood to adulthood, He underwent the same stages of growth seen in all people. Despite His divinity, Christ also shared in the sinless infirmities that are part of human nature. These included hunger (**Matthew 4:2**), thirst (**John 19:28**), fatigue (**John 4:6**), and sorrow—limitations and weaknesses common to humanity, yet entirely free from sin. In addition, Christ possessed all the essential elements of human nature. He had a physical body, a rational mind, and emotions, making Him fully human while remaining without sin. This complete identification with humanity allowed Him to truly understand and sympathize with human experiences.

Christ’s character serves as a profound example and guide for how we should live. He was absolutely holy (**1 Peter 2:22**), setting a standard of moral purity and righteousness in every aspect of His life. His love was genuine and selfless (**John 15:13**), reaching out to others with compassion and care. Christ was truly humble, never seeking His own glory but instead serving others with a gentle spirit (**Philippians 2:5-8**). He demonstrated thorough meekness, showing strength under control and responding to challenges with patience and grace (**Matthew 11:29**). His character was perfectly balanced, maintaining harmony between justice and mercy, strength and gentleness. Christ lived a life of constant prayer, maintaining a close relationship with God and seeking guidance through every circumstance (**Luke 6:12**). Lastly, He was an incessant worker, devoted to fulfilling His mission and serving others tirelessly (**John 5:17**). Each of these qualities illustrates the character that Christ modeled and encourages us to pursue in our own lives.






